Elaboration:

Crafted through the traditional "Night and Day" method, Garnacha and Viura grapes are macerated for one night and one day. The must is subsequently drawn off, imparting its distinctive color. Fermentation is deliberately halted to retain a portion of its natural sugars, enhancing balance and imparting a sweet character.

Appearance: A vibrant pale pink hue, striking and appealing, reminiscent of the classic clarets from Alto de Najerilla.

Nose: Pronounced primary aromas of ripe Grenache, featuring notes of strawberry and raspberry, complemented by stone fruits like peach and evocative hints of confections.

Palate: Harmoniously balanced between sweetness and acidity, featuring a subtle effervescence that enhances its freshness. Rich, succulent, and vibrant, with a lingering finish that encourages continued enjoyment.
